

Lake Ellen Boating Restriction In Effect Until Further Notice

As of July 15, 2010 boating activity on Lake Ellen has been restricted to “Slow no Wake” until further notice. As of that date, the Lake Ellen water level is 9 ¾ inches above unrestricted safe boating levels.

- The Town of Lyndon Sanitary Commission monitors the water level of Lake Ellen on an ongoing basis.
- In the event that the Lake exceeds a predetermined level, the Sanitary District will place a sign and orange flags at the public landing indicating that all boating is restricted to “Slow no Wake” at all times of the day.
- The restriction to “Slow no Wake “ is to avoid shoreline property damage from excessive boating wave action.
- Any violations; i.e., boating in excess of “Slow no Wake,” are subject to citations.
